It is also a sign that without praying, you belong to me. Wear the Brown Scapular and make a special consecration and connection to my Most Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart. Pray the St. Louis De Montfort prayer every day. Know that anyone who calls upon me as Mother of Mercy, they do not leave empty handed. I replace their sorrow with joy.
