

Message from MOTHER OF MERCY

To THE WORLD

April 25, 2008 through Chris Courtis, a visionary in Maryland, USA

Dear children, in the great peace and love of God I greet you!

My little ones, praised be Jesus!

I have spoken to you these two times (April 2 and 13, 2008) about natural disasters and suffering of every kind. Even My Son has given to you the message of sacrifice. The world is in danger. You are living in an age of the chastisement and the great purification. Little ones, you must stop offending God!

When I give you a warning, you must realize that God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit is speaking through me. The warning is – there shall be great natural disasters of every kind – famines, droughts, floods, hurricanes, earthquakes and epidemics of every kind. You will experience these things through the bowls of God's justice and His purification which is being unleashed now upon you.

Pray, pray, pray and amend your ways! My dear children, my message remains the same as in Fatima, Portugal in 1917. I came and I asked three shepherd children to make sacrifices and to pray for peace. My message is the same. You will not find peace until you return to the Lord.

Also, in 1917, I gave you the hope and the means for your hope – the Rosary. The Rosary alone can work miracles. The Rosary alone can give to your hearts peace. Pray the Rosary twice a day and amend your ways!

Now, my second message, my final message.

I am the Mother of Mercy.

My dear little children, praised be Jesus!

My dear children, today, like never before do I call you to veneration of the Most Holy Cross. Through Jesus' crucifixion, not only do you obtain salvation but I became your merciful mother. It was through suffering that He redeemed you, and it was through suffering that I became your mother. His heart was pierced with a lance on the Cross opening wide the door to His mercy. My heart was pierced with a sword of sorrows, thus opening wide the door to my mercy for the world. It was at the Cross that I became your Mother of Mercy. As Jesus' suffering was the redemption of the world, ALL the world, especially to those who accept Him, I through my suffering became the Mother of Mercy for all people, for all nations, of all religions, and creeds.

I pour forth graces as the Mediatrix of Graces, and I pour forth my Son's mercy mingled with mine as the Mediatrix of His mercy and mine to humanity. Meditate upon the Cross, where not only I became your mother but where salvation was wrought, where three mercies became one – God the Father's mercy, Jesus' mercy, and mine.

I also invite you to the presence of God the Father being given to you through Eucharistic Adoration. As you adore Jesus in Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament, so too do you adore

the Father. Because Jesus has said often, “The Father and I are one.” Those who accept Jesus accept the Father who has sent Him. Therefore, when you are kneeling, praising, and giving your love to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and in Adoration, you are giving adoration to God the Father.

Bless you, my little ones, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen. I love you, dear children, and I take your petitions into my Most Sorrowful and Merciful Heart, and I will present them to the Most Holy Trinity and to Jesus whom I hold in my arms.

As I bless you again, my dear children, I shall bless you and all that you have with you, all that’s on the altar, by the altar, under the altar, everything you have on and everything in this room, I will bless, and my Son Jesus will extend His little hands in blessing and healing for those in need.

After this blessing, I shall depart. I shall depart to the Most Holy Trinity, but I shall always be with you, all of you, when, and especially when, you pray. Please don’t forget to pray, pray, pray! I bless you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. (*Jesus’ hands are raised out over us. He’s making the Sign of the Cross too, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.*) Thank you for responding to my call. Go in the great peace, love, mercy, and joy of God. Ad Deum.
