My little ones,

Always in a special way they shall remain, but I have come to announce a time of change, the beginning of the ending of these appearances. After these are done, you will only experience two apparitions – one on your (Chris') birthday and one publicly for everyone on May 25th of each year. Pray and rekindle your hearts and dedicate your hearts all to God the Father for through His Heart you are consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Rejoice, oh little children, for this is the beginning of something new, something special, something glorious! I am here to lead all souls to God.

The message that I wish to deliver for the world is: little ones, renew your hope and your faith within the Cross. I am the Angel of the Annunciation. I am the Angel of the Incarnation and of the Cross. Jesus' whole purpose in coming among you was to die on the Cross for your sins and for your salvation. That is why I wear the gold embroidered cross upon my white garments, to remind people that not only was I there at the Annunciation but I am the special Angel of Jesus' Cross for I was there.

Little children, my little ones of God, your whole purpose should be one of conforming to the Cross. Let your hearts be pressed upon the Cross and the suffering Savior. Offer your sufferings and your sacrifices to God for your brothers and sisters who continue to live in great sin. You will renew hope. You will renew faith. You will renew your love for God but only by going to the Cross of Calvary. Through your sufferings you will be renewed in joy but the Cross must come first. The Cross must always be first, before you renew your hope, before you renew your faith, and before you renew your love. You must suffer! This is the only sign that distinguishes you as true children of God – the Cross. Let that and nothing else *be* your salvation and *be* your joy in suffering. Renew your commitment to the Cross, pray and meditate upon it daily. Learn to be quiet. Learn to love your Lord who has suffered so dearly for the price of your salvation.

All those who come to the Cross will find me, St. Gabriel the Archangel. Now I shall extend my hands to give you the blessing of God, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. I take your petitions to Him who has sent me which is the Most Holy Trinity. And now I shall depart. Go in the great peace of God Most High. Ad Deum.
